

Dear Navigator Families,

We appreciate your patience, understanding, and support as we journey through this process. There may be changes, adjustments, and corrections along the way. Please know that we are doing our best to make decisions that are in the best interest of our staff, students, families, and community with the limited and ever-changing information we have.

We are encouraging all of our school families to come and pick up their child's school books and supplies as some of the assignments will be based from the students' books. Thank you to the many families who came to our school on Friday and Saturday. We will still have our school open on Monday from 7:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Our teachers in Preschool - Grade 4 will provide students with activity/lesson packets for the first week along with a simplified lesson plan/checklist for the students/parents. The teachers will email the information to each family by Monday by 8:30 a.m. For our students in grades 5 - 8, they will stay engaged with their academics through Google classroom. All students in grades 5 - 8 and special teachers will post assignments/ lesson plans on Headmaster each morning by 8:30 a.m. We are still working out the kinks to the videos. Please bear with us!

The same academic protocol will follow the week after spring break (March 23 - 27). No academic work will be given during spring break. Please be patient with us as we try new education venues. The goal is to offer rich academic opportunities for students during the closure period. If you have questions regarding the assignments, please email teachers directly. This plan may be reassessed and adjusted should the governor decide to extend the closure period.

We encourage you to keep your children engaged and create a new home schedule which includes chores, family time, prayer, play time, and quiet time.
