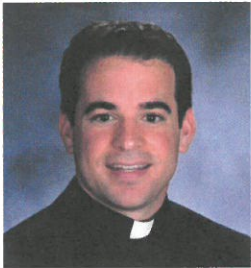
FEATURED SPEAKERS

Tim Staples



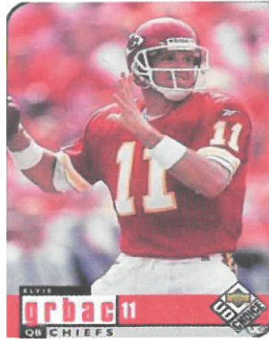

He converted to Catholicism in 1986, and spent the next six years studying for the Catholic Priesthood, receiving a degree in Philosophy from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in the Philadelphia area. He then began theology studies at Mt. St. Mary's Seminary in Maryland. Tim left the seminary in 1994 and has been working at Catholic Apologetics and Evangelization ever since; publishing articles, blogging, producing radio shows and videos, as well as speaking at events around the US.
