SFX 5th Graders Make a Difference!

The 5th graders organized a "Make a Change" fundraiser the week of May 19th for their service project this year. They collected pennies on Monday, nickels on Tuesday, dimes on Wednesday, and quarters on Thursday. The money raised went to Medina County Jobs and Family Services to help foster children in the county. The students used the money they collected to put together birthday boxes for foster children. The boxes included party supplies, gift cards and other items. The 5th graders also wrote letters to local businesses asking for donations and received a variety of things such as pizza and cake coupons, gift cards and passes to roller skate, play putt-putt and laser tag. To advertise the fundraiser at the school, the students made PowerPoint presentations and presented them to each classroom. They also made posters and gave announcements over the PA. Their goal was to raise \$600 and they raised \$876. The National Junior Honor Society gave them \$124, which made the total \$1000! The students put together over 20 birthday boxes and the extra money raised is going toward sending some of the foster children to summer camps. We are so very proud of our 5th graders and the hard work that they put in for the success of their Service Project.

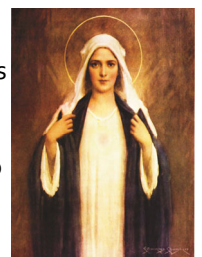

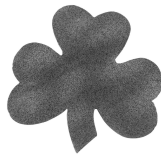

Celebrating the Reception of Becky Weaver and Norm Daugherty Into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Becky Weaver was baptized at the Northwest Bible Church in Hilliard, Ohio, and Norm Daugherty was baptized at the Inter-Faith Chapel in London, Ohio. To prepare for their Rite of Reception into the Catholic Church, Becky and Norm have attended Mass, Scripture Breaking and RCIA sessions since their Jan. 5 Rite of Welcome. Prior to this rite, Becky and Norm participated in a three-month period of inquiry that overviewed Catholic teaching and practice, addressed doctrinal differences and answered questions on matters of faith and morality.

Becky and her husband, Chuck, moved to Medina in August 2012. Both are employed at Westfield Insurance. Chuck (a baptized Lutheran) is a learning and development leader, and Becky is a national claims leader. The couple has a daughter named Hannah, who is a student at St. Francis Xavier School. Hannah was in Mrs. Esterburg's first-grade class this year. Pursuing a lifelong interest, Becky began her exploration of the Catholic faith when Hannah started the first grade. Hannah was automatically received into the Catholic Church with her mother on June 22. Next year, Hannah will make her Profession of Faith and receive her First Holy Eucharist.

Norm and his wife, Mary, moved to Medina County from Brook Park about nine years ago. Norm is employed by Ganley Westside Imports in the parts department, as a delivery truck driver. Mary is a homemaker. Norm and Mary have been married for 34 years and have two sons, Mike (age 33) and Matt (age 29). Mike and Matt are sports enthusiasts, participating in the Special Olym-

pics in basketball, bowling and track and field. Mary, a devout cradle Catholic, made sure the boys were baptized and raised in the Catholic Church. Norm would sporadically attend Mass with Mary and the boys on holidays and special occasions. When asked why he decided to officially join the Church, Norm stated that he desired religious unity in the family. Mary, who served as his sponsor, jokes that Norm *suddenly* decided to become Catholic after 34 years!
