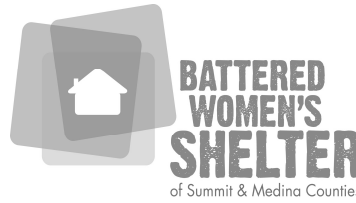


TEENS SERVE MAGGIE'S PLACE

Paper Products: Paper towels, toilet paper, Kleenex, laundry soap, dish soap, sponges, diapers/wipes

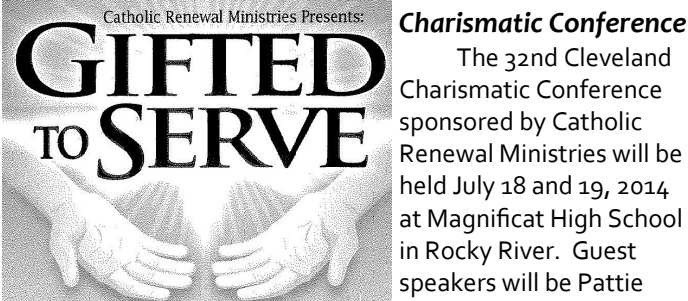
Medicine: Pain relievers, TUMS, Pepto-Bismol, Children's Tylenol, allergy relievers
