Music Ministry Notes:

The parish has begun singing the revised COMMUNITY MASS setting by Richard Proulx THIS weekend. SFX has sung the old version of the mass setting for years, so this should not be as difficult as learning the new mass of SAINT PAUL the APOSTLE, which we learned back in Advent of 2011. The words are all the same as we have been singing the last 3 years. The music ministry will be singing WITHOUT harmony for the first few months to help everyone learn the mass setting; the harmonies written for this mass will be added later in the fall. The *Gloria* is the only new melody that was added to this mass setting, and it taught as we learned the MASS of SAINT PAUL *Gloria*, through immersion: singing along when comfortable. The great thing about any of these new mass settings is that THE WORDS ARE ALWAYS THE SAME, just the melodies are different.
