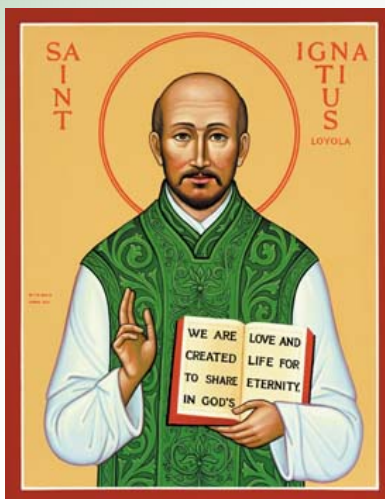
Next weekend should be the last weekend before the parking lot is open if all goes well. (I am not holding my breath.) Please follow the directions of the Knights until it is striped.
