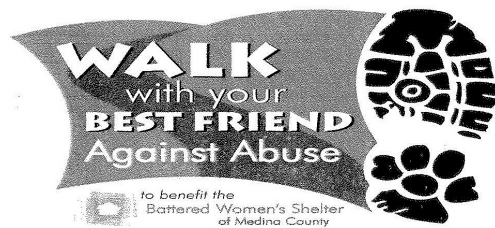

Pastor's Page

I am pleased to pass along some good news that I received on Monday of this week from the Diaconate Formation Office. One of our parishioners, who has been an aspirant for the last year has been formally accepted into the formation program for the Diaconate. We congratulate and pray for Bob Cavanaugh who will be admitted to Candidacy this Sunday, August 10th at the 5:30 p.m. Mass at St. John Cathedral. If you are able to make the trip downtown for the Mass, please do, to support Bob as he more formally begins this process of discernment and formation to serve the Church one day as a deacon. I know that I will be there to concelebrate as will many of the staff and friends of Bob and Dawn. Please continue to keep him, Dino Paoletta and all those in formation at the seminaries and pastoral ministry office in your prayers as they continue to be formed as ministers in the Church.

Another piece of good news is similar, but different. John Carroll University has a two year program called the Institute for Ignatian Spirituality. It is a masters level program, that incorporates, spirituality, psychology, spiritual direction, theology, scripture and pastoral counseling. Mike Sweet has been accepted into the program. He is married to Sue and they have a son in college. Mike takes care of our parish greens. He, with Brian Lombardy and Deacon Paul, began SPA here a number of years ago to help adults develop a more vibrant spirituality and active prayer life. Please continue to pray for him and his classmates in the program.

In just one week school will begin. Remember that the flow of traffic is to enter the property through the East Smith Road Driveway. The Fire Lane in front of the School, Rectory and Church is one way from the east to the west. Please drive extra slow.

Progress has continued on the big dig. On Tuesday they started pouring between the rectory and school and continued to make their way out to the rest of the parking lot. It will take 7 days of curing before we can use it.

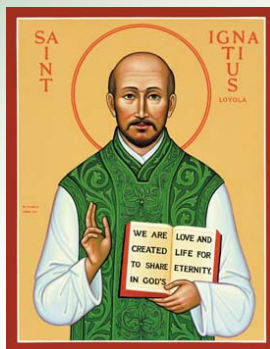
