Kindergarten STEM in Action!

Mrs. Plute-Schlitter’s Kindergarten class had a great time participating in their first STEM activity of the year! After watching Brain Pop Jr online videos about materials used to build and examples of monumental structures engineered by everyday people, they started searching for pictures of these buildings.



The students were then placed into small groups and given a picture of one of the buildings found and told they were going to replicate them using large wooden blocks. The

groups had to count how many parts made up the building so they knew how many blocks they would need and what shapes would make sense. The structures had to be sturdy enough to stand alone! They worked together cooperatively picking out the blocks and redesigning the structure. After, the students got to share their work with fellow Kindergarteners in Mrs. Beal’s class and Mrs. Seislove as well as Mrs. Herman! We can’t wait to start planning our next STEM activity.

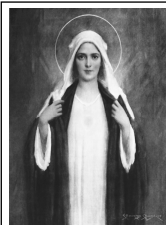
