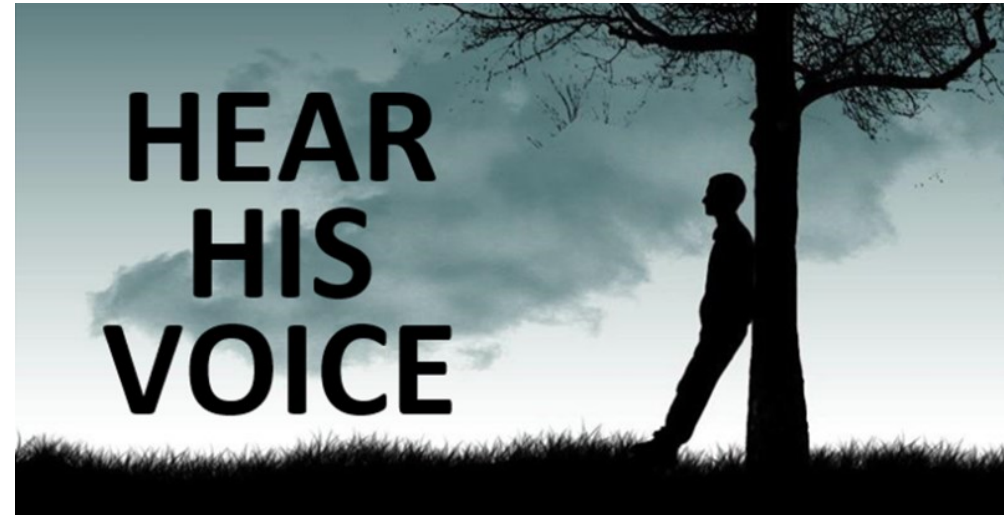

WHAT IS CHRIST RENEWS HIS PARISH (CRHP) MEN'S RENEWAL?

The men's renewal weekend is an opportunity for men of our parish to relax, pray, and grow in their relationship with Christ and others. The CRHP program has been offered at St. Francis for over thirty years.

As a renewal attendee you can expect to hear each of the current team members give a "witness" about his life and where he is in his relationship with God; you can also expect some time to quietly pray and reflect on your own life; and you are guaranteed a day-and-a-half to simply relax. There's no need to share and no pressure to say much of anything. Just sit back, relax, and listen.

In addition you will be given the opportunity to participate in Reconciliation and to attend Mass on Sunday morning.

WHO CAN ATTEND? WHAT COMMITMENT IS NECESSARY?

Any Catholic man, age 18 or older, who is a registered parishioner at St. Francis Xavier, may attend. Renewalists come in all types: young and old, married and single, regular church attendees and those looking to get back to church. Don't worry that you won't fit in at renewal. Renewal was made just for you.

You will arrive at the Xavier Room of the school on Saturday morning, March 5, at 8:30 am, for a full day of CRHP activities. You will spend the night on the SFX campus with the other renewalists. The weekend will end at approximately 4:00 pm on Sunday afternoon, March 6.

There is no cost for the weekend. However, we ask that you consider making a free-will donation to the SFX CRHP program sometime after the weekend. This can be dropped in the weekly collection basket.
