- Please consider purchasing e-cards as these are available for immediate use



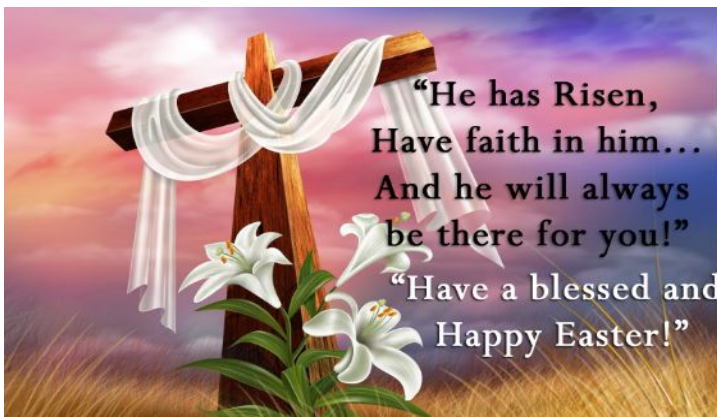
